

A device for climbing, descent and work at a height, containing a flexible tie, at one end of which a means for securing it to a support is fixed, and at the other end - a securing means in the form of a belt with a buckle is mounted, the flexible tie is made as a rope, and the securing means to the support - as a chain with a safety hook, the means for securing a worker to the rope additionally has a loop-like holder in the form of under shoulder and over shoulder loops of the rope, connected between them and to a fixing bar, put on by its hole on the rope, a braking and catching mechanism, mounted on the belt buckle, which contains two movable braking blocks, enclosing the rope from both sides by its buckled surfaces and acting together with the provided by the handles eccentrics, which are mounted on the buckle with a possibility to rotate and double fixing of the belt to its buckle, a feet support, made as a oval frame with the spring hinges at its sides, with the middle hinges and struts, provided by the opposite disposed shackles for the rope enclosing, and provided by the elastic hinges for the feet enclosing.
