

The invention relates to a method for producing brushware having plastic bristles, according to which the bristles (3) are produced by continuous extrusion as monofilaments, cut to the desired length and fixed to a bristle support individually or in groups to serve as bristle trim (2). According to the invention the monofilament formed by extrusion or the bristles (3) produced therefrom are provided with at least one substantially linear demarcation which can be identified at the level of the bristle trim of the finished brushware article as a colour marking (9) and is situated at a distance from the useable end of the bristles (3), said distance indicating the state of use. In a brushware article produced according to this method at least a part of the bristles situated outside the bristle trim (2) comprises a substantially linear demarcation in the form of a colour marking which is situated at a distance from the useable end of the bristles, said distance indicating the state of use of same.
