

A shoe box is made of a flat blank, divided with the lines of bending into areas forming the bottom, the side and end walls. Side walls are made with flaps which have a tongues. The end sides are made with flaps and have additional corner right-angled flaps. Additional corner flaps of the end walls have possibility of installation to segment openings arranged at the lines of bending of the side walls and flaps adjoining those walls. One of the flaps of the side wall has an elongation, dividing the box into two parts.
